



Welcome to the 2026 Boulia Camel Races!

Conditions of Entry

The Boulia Camel Races is a family-friendly community event that welcomes visitors from across Australia and overseas. These Conditions of Entry are designed to promote a safe, inclusive and enjoyable environment for all patrons, volunteers, competitors, contractors, exhibitors and staff.

By entering the event venue, all patrons acknowledge that they have read, understood and agree to comply with these Conditions of Entry.

Behaviour

We expect behaviour of all persons attending our event to: Treat others with courtesy, dignity & respect, behave in a safe, responsible & lawful manner at all times, follow reasonable directions issued by committee, security personnel, volunteers, emergency services or authorised officers, respect event infrastructure, equipment, facilities, livestock, competitors and the surrounding environment, help maintain an atmosphere that is welcoming & enjoyable for everyone. Defined unacceptable behaviour is listed further down as well as responsibilities in the consumption of Alcohol.

Accessibility

Must-do Housekeeping

Children remain the responsibility of their parent/guardian. Parents/Guardians are expected to supervise their children appropriately.

Dogs (including service dogs) must be restrained at all times. Please be considerate of toileting – we encourage utilising the grassed area at the rear of the shed. Please ensure all excrement is picked up. No dogs are permitted in proximity or within visibility of camels. Owners remain responsible for the behaviours of the approved animals. By entering the event, patrons acknowledge that photographs, video recordings & live broadcasts may occur.

Event attendees acknowledge that attendance at an outdoor event involves inherent risks including; uneven ground, dust, noise, changing weather conditions, livestock, moving vehicles, machinery, sporting activities, large crowds. Event attendees accept



responsibility for exercising reasonable care for their own safety & the safety of those in their care.

Event organisers reserve (and empower hired security) the right to: inspect bags/wagons/prams where lawful, refuse entry, deny service, direct patrons to leave an area, involve the Qld Police Service or emergency services where necessary. Any person directed to leave the venue must do so immediately. Return entry will be determined by consultation with relevant persons whether return entry will be permitted. Flasks are not permitted, boots/jackets may be requested to be removed for inspection.

Any person may be refused entry or removed from the venue where they: breach these conditions of entry, behave in a manner that threatens safety, damage property, interfere with event operations, commit an offence, failure to comply with reasonable directions from committee, security or emergency services personnel. Removal from event may occur with no refund and may result in a ban from future events.

Patrons who witness unsafe or inappropriate behaviour are encouraged to immediately notify: Event Organiser (0428581874) or President (0429434279) or security personnel. Early reporting assists in maintaining a safe event for all.

By entering the Boulia Racecourse Reserve for attendance of the Boulia Camel Races event you acknowledge that:

1. You have read these conditions of entry
2. You agree to comply with these conditions
3. You understand that failure to comply may result in refusal of entry or removal from the venue; and
4. You accept personal responsibility for behaving safely, respectfully & responsibly throughout the event

Further information:

Camp sites are not allocated - please be sensible with parking. Fire Safety comes first and sites will be asked to relocate if there is a concern.

Be considerate of the accessible area – we understand this in the past has been the locals/noisy area and this has changed. As we need to ensure we are catering for those without full movement/requiring additional supports for attendance you will notice that the following has been put in place for 2026 event:

- Accessible camping area in triangular section upon entry
- Unisex Accessible toilet – located in shed @ ladies entrance
- Pathways defined on cement flooring of shed & pickets/bunting – these will need to be utilised as thoroughfares and not seating/standing to enjoy your drink zones.
- As put in place in 2025 – seats are no longer permitted along the racetrack fence, this is viewing area only. There WILL be a defined inclusive access area – please respect this.



- Not all disabilities are visible, we respect this but in order to provide fair access to our event – if utilising one of these spaces you may be approached by security or committee. If evidence is unable to be produced you may be exited from the event.
- Gateways need to be kept clear at all times – standing in front of a ‘no standing’ sign is not acceptable

Camel Tagging Arena

Camel Tagging is located across the racetrack. Microphone announcement will call for initial access for those requiring supported access. Further calls will allow for crossing of the track of event participants (waivers & nomination completed) followed by announcement for all persons to find their seating. There is limited seating & spacing, please be mindful & considerate of one another. Camel Tagging is streamed on the television screens in the shed.

Gas Heaters

- Please do not relocate gas heaters or umbrellas from original location
- Committee members will be responsible for turning on gas heaters & setting of heat. This is to ensure they last through the night, please do not change the setting – failure to adhere will result in being asked to leave

Communications

- Phone service may struggle during peak periods – calls should function at all times – data and messaging capacity will drop out
- Due to the other 500 caravans around also having starlink, this may become congested also
- Free wifi is available at the Min Min Encounter in town
- Computer usage is available at the Boulia Library during business hours

Glamping

- Crossing of the track during the day is not permitted (Between 9:30am & 5pm Saturday, 9:30am & 12:30pm Sunday)

Bringing in of External Items

- No glass containers/drinkware
- No alcohol
- No open water bottles, yeti's must be emptied upon entry
- No fireworks, sparklers, cap guns, air horn
- No weapons of any type
- No laser pointers
- No strobe style flashing lights
- No speakers/music boxes



Volunteers

Those that volunteer their time in support of our event are genuinely appreciated. We take our event operations, safety & security seriously. Being under the influence or consuming alcohol while undertaking committed volunteer shift is not permitted. If it is assumed that the volunteer is under the influence – the volunteer may be requested to undertake a breathalyser test. Failure to adhere to standard may result in removal from event & future attendance banned.

Volunteers on Track – Event Support

All volunteers that assist with the operations involving being present on the racetrack are required to be breathalysed at 9am on Saturday & Sunday morning. Zero alcohol is mandatory for presence on the racetrack at all times. Failure to adhere may result in removal from event & future ban.

Unacceptable Behaviour

The following behaviours will not be tolerated:

- Physical violence or aggressive behaviour.
- Verbal abuse, intimidation or threatening behaviour.
- Harassment, bullying or discrimination.
- Offensive, abusive or obscene language directed towards another person.
- Wilful damage or vandalism.
- Throwing objects.
- Fighting or encouraging others to fight.
- Behaviour that places another person at risk.
- Refusal to comply with lawful directions from authorised personnel.
- Entering restricted or prohibited areas.
- Interfering with competitors, officials, livestock or event operations.
- Any unlawful conduct.

Patrons must:

- Consume alcohol responsibly
- Comply with all liquor licensing requirements
- Produce acceptable identification when requested
- Not supply alcohol to minors
- Not consume, distribute or sell illicit/recreational prescription drugs
- Not bring prohibited alcohol into restricted licenced areas unless authorised
- Free Drinking water is available from the bar

Persons who are intoxicated or behaving in a manner that compromises safety may be refused entry or removed from the venue.

Service Fees – all drink tickets are refundable
